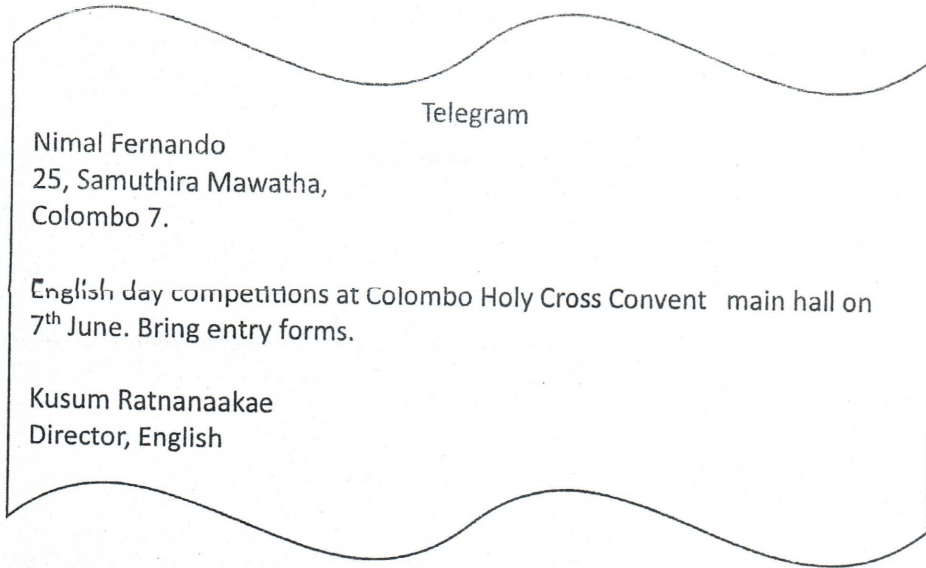

Making compost is probably the single most important thing you can do for your organic garden. Making compost isn't difficult. With very little effort on your part, you can turn throw-away materials into this sweet-smelling, nutrient-rich, no-cost soil conditioner.

Chop materials as finely as you can before mixing them into the pile. Mix dry browns and wet greens. The two basic types of ingredients for making compost are those rich in carbon and those rich in nitrogen. Carbon-rich materials, or "dry browns," include leaves, hay, and straw. Nitrogen-rich materials, or "wet greens," include kitchen scraps and grass clippings. Your goal is to keep a fair mix of these materials throughout the pile. Build the pile at least 3 x 3 x 3 feet so materials will heat up and decompose quickly. Check the pile a couple of days after it is built up — it should be hot in the middle, a sign that your microbial decomposers are working hard. Add water as needed.
