



3)	Global Warming

like oil and coal causes greenhouse gases such as carbon dioxide to act like a warm blanket over the earth.

One way to reduce greenhouse gases is to reduce deforestation, the cutting down trees. Trees soak up carbon dioxide from the air, so having lots of trees around is good for the atmosphere.

There are already some changes happening because of global warming. Sea level is rising and some animals are moving to new homes because their natural habitat is disappearing. If the warming gets worse, as scientists expect, there may be some kinds of plants and animals that become extinct.

There may be more storms and floods. Due to melting ice caps, sea levels may rise so much that people have to move away from the coasts. Some areas may become too dry for farming.
