How many new words enter the English language every year? Unfortunately no list is kept. In France there is the Academie Francaise which approves new words but in England there are only dictionaries.

The most authoritative of these is *Oxford English Dictionary* (OED) which has twenty volumes, but this does not make rules about the language. It simply records the development of English worldwide as best as it can. It accepts 4000 new words (or new meanings) every year.

The OED has readers all English speaking parts of the world, who record repeated uses of new words, including numerous technical terms. Some terms take surprisingly long time to enter the OED. For example 'acid rain' was first used in 1959, but its usage was rare for over 100 years and it did not appear in the dictionary until 1980s.

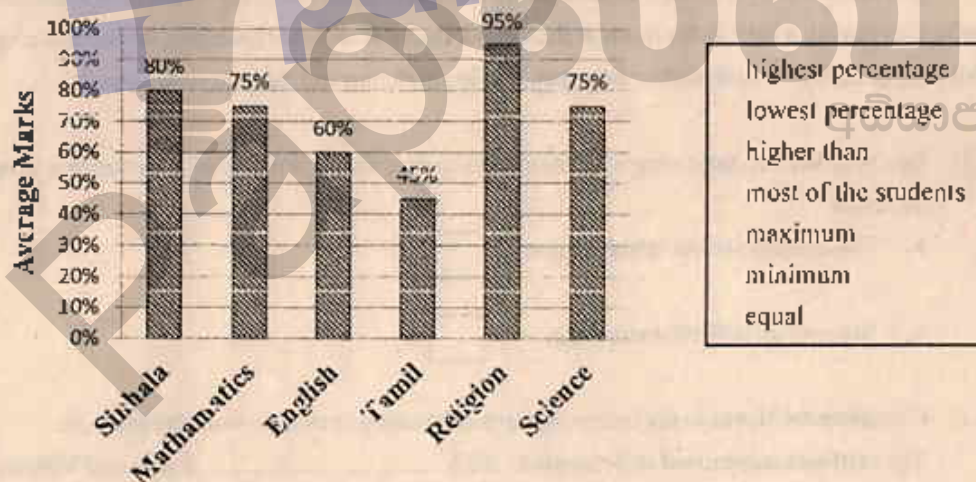

Tsunami in Japan

At two minutes to noon in September 1923, the great clock in Tokyo stopped. Tokyo bay shook as if a huge rug had been pulled from under it. Towering above the bay, the 4000 meter Mount Fuji stood above the deep trench in the sea, it was from this trench the earthquake came, at the magnitude of 8.3 on the Richter scale.

The sea drew back for a few minutes. Then the huge wave swept over the city. Boats were carried inland, and buildings and people were dragged out to sea. The shaken dislodged part of a hill side, which gave way, brushing trains, stations and bodies in to the water below. Large sections of the sea bed sank 400 meters; the land rose by 250 meters in some places and sank in others. Three massive shocks wrecked the cities of Tokyo and Yokohama and, during the next six hours, there were 171 aftershocks.

The casualties were enormous, but there were also some lucky survivors. The most remarkable was a boy who was having a bath in his room at the Grand Tokyo Residence building. As the building collapsed, he and his bath gracefully descended to the street, leaving both him and the bath water intact.
