Love him when he comes

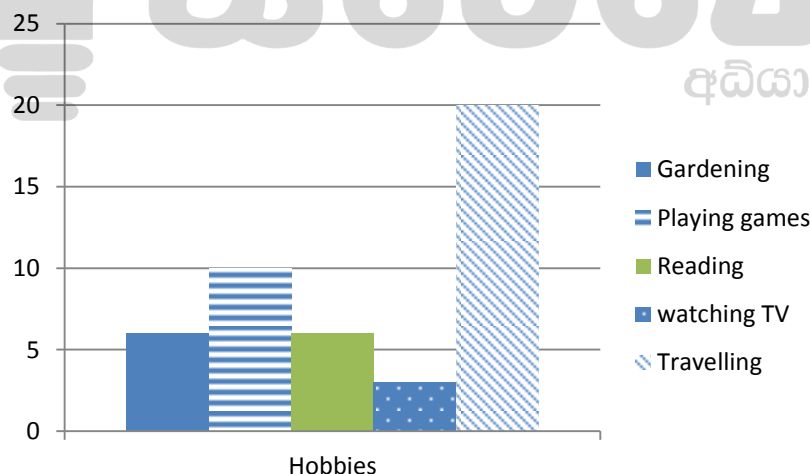
